VI. Director's Report – Jason Cheskawich

- PMEA wind ensemble was awesome. Percussion will have their concert series in a few weeks.
- memorial parade is coming up.
- Band concert: 3 scholarships will be awarded.
- Night at the Grove – was a success (\$1,600). The jazz band will be performing at the Spaghetti dinner.
- the budget is on the website. (There was some discussion on budget cuts) – If we must pay for trucks, we may have to carry that burden. There has been no communication on the transportation budget from the district as of now (issues of bus, truck, and trailer – not answered). We need to plan for the worst. We are expected to show up for all football games, parades & competitions.
- truck rental = about \$ 10,000. Buses are not included – every Friday night, at least one is rental.
- we are trying to set the yearly dues low and hoping fundraisers& sponsorship will help fund things.
- right now, with so many uncertainties (including field times) we are not sure what the next season would look like.
- the field time schedule is not out yet. We do not know why the field time was cut.
- upper practice field – we used to have 2 rehearsals a week but that disappeared.
- according to the district - the program has outgrown the district support.
- Parking lot - is that an option? The district does not support in helping traffic restrictions on the lot or restrictive parking. The parking lot is not an acceptable option.
- possible usage of other fields? – there are more sports, hence more demand. If we have lights, we will have no issues for practice, especially on the upper field. Ideally, we need 6 hours a week for practice. 4-5 hours is workable.
- discussions in public forums such as the school board meeting may help. (school board meeting is 13th & 20th)

- more HS administration rather than district administration has been providing the directive.
- Football – FYI the Blue Devil football booster organization does provide a lot of money to the sport.
- the district does make money on rentals.
